**The St. Clare of Assisi Fund** is used for women and children of poverty with the collection date set on or around Mother's Day each year. The St. Clare of Assisi Fund was established to enable the members of The Episcopal Community to reach out and support projects in the United States that specifically help women and children. The name was chosen because Clare was first and foremost a woman of prayer and of unparalleled spirituality. The first ingathering for the fund will be on Mother's Day, but it is hoped that contributions will come in all year long to support the selected projects.

**The St. Mary Magdalene Financial Assistance Fund** is used to help with dues payment for members with limited income due to life circumstances. It will be collected with dues.

**The Tribute Fund** was established to honor others who have touched our lives in meaningful way, either alive or deceased, or in honor of a birthday, baptism, or other special life event. The Tribute Funds are unrestricted.
